

COMMUNITY IMPACT/OUTREACH MEETING

PUBLIC HEARING

- Public Hearing must contain the time, place and subject matter of the meeting, including the proposed address of the Marijuana Establishment. Notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city or town at least seven calendar days prior to the hearing
- A copy of the meeting notice must be filed with the town or city clerk, the planning board, the contracting authority for the municipality, and local licensing authority for adult use of marijuana (if applicable).
- A copy of the legal notice mailed to abutters and other parties of interest identified in the regulations.

INFORMATION DISCUSSED:

Information presented at the public hearing must include:

- The type(s) of Marijuana Establishment to be located at the proposed address (Grow/Distribution facility, Retail facility, medical Marijuana facility etc.).
- Adequate information to demonstrate that the location will be maintained securely; steps to be taken by the Marijuana Establishment to prevent diversion to minors.
- A plan developed by the Marijuana Establishment to help positively impact the community.
- Adequate information to demonstrate that the location will not become a nuisance to the people and businesses surrounding the facility.
- Q & A: community members are permitted to ask questions and receive answers from representatives of the proposed Marijuana facility/Establishment.
